A P E A C E R E S E A R C H C O U R S E

February 21st - May 31st 1970

We believe that a great deal more research and action is needed in all aspects of peace, especially in light of our present world and individual situations of tension and hostilities. Therefore, in connection with our current program we are offering a course in peace and peace research from February 21st to May 31st, 1970.

The lectures and discussions will be at the undergraduate level and will include such topics and areas as: Survey of Peace Research and Peace Action - Cybernetical and Game Theoretical Aspects - Simulation Techniques - Developing Countries - International Economics - Biological Foundations - Conflict and Aggression Theory - Social Change - Cross-Cultural Comparisons - War/Peace Attitude Change and Formation - International Relations - Futurology - "World Peace Through World Law" - "Emergency World Government" - Disarmament versus Balance of Power - Non Violence - Peace Value of Religion and Esoteric Disciplines - Peace Education.

The course will total about 17 hours weekly and will be presented by our faculty of 8 peace researchers, augmented by visiting lecturers and professors. Attempts will be made to design the courses so as to equip the student with knowledge and experience that he can use effectively in his own peace work. Therefore, as the need arises, other courses will be made available, such as the following: Arabic, Dutch, French, German, Italian, Russian, Sanskrit, Spanish and other languages; Psychology, Sociology, Astrology, Sensitivity Training, Literature, etc.

The working language will be English.

Price: 500 US Dollars for tuition, room and board during the whole period.

At Hesbjerg Castle there is an excellent opportunity for students and resource people alike to form a creative community, thus experiencing what is needed for World Peace.

In addition to the Peace Research College, Hesbjerg has 20 young men and women preparing for University entrance. Students and faculty are taken from all parts of the world.

Hesbjerg Castle is ideally situated for such a program. It is immediately surrounded by hills and forests where many peace minded people have spent their vacation while attending Hesbjerg Summer Schools for the past 6 years. Hesbjerg is in the middle of Denmark, only 15 minutes away from the University City of Odense, the birthplace of Hans Christian Andersen. A drive 3 hours to the west will take you to Aarhus in Jutland, while 3 hours to the east, on Seeland, is Copenhagen.

Applicants should, above all, have a concern for humanity and, preferably, some university education or equivalent. Applications should include a short biography, a summary of education and recent work experience, and special interests. They should be sent as soon as possible.
