In accordance with a recommendation of the Political Commission of the Fifth Plenary Assembly of the Federation we have the honour to draw to your attention

(1) The text of Resolution 36 adopted by the Fifth Plenary Assembly,

(2) The text of the draft resolution presented by the Austrian League for the United Nations,

(3) The text of the Statement on Aggression issued by the League of Nations in May 1933.

May we draw your attention to the fact that the Resolution adopted on September 11th 1950 urges all UN Associations to give careful consideration to this matter and to report to WFUNA before 31 January 1951.

The Executive Committee has requested the Secretary-General to present to the General Council, on February 2nd, a report on the progress made in the study of this question. We would therefore be glad to receive your comments on this matter by the date mentioned in the resolution.
